 - g. Applicants travel expenditure (upto 2 times per academic year)

Eligibility Criteria:

1. Indian National and Resident
2. Admitted to a highly reputable university in US/ Europe (e.g. US universities will be judged by their US News ranking)
3. Admitted in a under – graduate/ graduate course in one of the following majors:
 - a. Science
 - b. Technology
 - c. Engineering
 - d. Mathematics
4. Excellent academic background

Supporting Documents Required:

1. Copy University's Admission Offer Letter
2. Copy of issued I – 20
3. Copy of Applicant's valid Passport
4. SAT I Score Card
5. SAT II Score Card: for at least 2 subject tests
6. Secondary School Result: CBSE AISSE Marksheet (or equivalent Secondary School Marksheet)
7. Senior Secondary School: International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma or CBSE AISSE Marksheet (or equivalent Senior Secondary School Marsheet)
8. Statement of Purpose
 - a. Applicant's Statement of Purpose should applicant's academic statement. It should include a description of why you want to study your proposed STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering or Mathematics) field, why you want to study at your chosen university, and how our program can help you achieve your professional goals.
9. Personal History Statement
 - a. The Personal History Statement should convey how a combination of life experiences, idealism, role models, education and work experiences have influenced your decision to apply. You may also include any educational, familial, cultural, economic or social experiences, challenges or opportunities relevant to your academic journey.

10. Letter of Recommendation:

- a. A Letter of Recommendation from an Academic/ Extra-Curricular/ Professional mentor or supervisor.

11. Resume

12. Copy Other Supporting Documents (optional):

- a. Certificates and accolades in the field of Sports and Athletics
- b. Certificates and accolades in the field of other extra-curricular vocations
